## TO OUR RECTOR

The Bishop of Chichester, Dr Martin Warner, has appointed six new Honorary Canons of Chichester Cathedral, one of which is our Rector, Kathryn. The announcement means that Kathryn will be able to use the title Canon and she is allocated a stall in the choir at the Cathedral Church. Dr Warner said that the announcement was "in recognition of the contribution that they make to the apostolic life of the diocese."
