ZOOM SERVICE

You may have heard that we have been experimenting with Zoom to produce a Sunday Eucharist service at 10 am each Sunday during lockdown. If you would rather not come to Church just yet then you will be pleased to know that the Zoom service will be continuing at 10am on Sundays for the time being. Den Cowdrey will send out the link as usual. If you haven't yet joined in our Zoom service then email Val Rice (valrice77@gmail.com) and ask her to add you to the list – she will arrange for you to be included in the Zoom group. Den will even talk you through what you need to do to join in!

In order to participate you will need a computer or tablet with a camera and microphone. In addition, you will need to install the free version of the Zoom app. If you need help getting set up, Den Cowdrey (cowdrey34189@icloud.com) is more than happy to assist.

You will need to register yourself on Zoom, then you log in on Sunday morning about 10 minutes before 10am - this will give Den time to ensure everything is working correctly. An order of service will be emailed on Saturday morning containing details of Celebrant, Preacher and who is reading the Lessons and Intercessions. Details of the readings will be included on the order of service. The order of service will be a Word document so that you will be able to print and follow the service on hard copy.
